CUSTOMIZING YOUR ACCOUNT


You might want to customize your profile settings, particularly:

BBCodes

BBCode is a type of formatting that can be applied to your post content, much like HTML. Unlike HTML, however, BBCode uses square brackets [and] instead of angled brackets < and >. For detailed instructions on the usage of BBCode, you can click the BBCode link to the righthand of the Post Content text box.

Basic BBCodes and their outputs are as follows:

[b]Boldface text[/b]: Boldface text [i]Italicised text[/i]: Italicised text

[u]Underlined text[/u]: Underlined text

[quote]Quoted text[/quote]

[quote="Name to quote"]Quoted text[/quote]

[url]https://www.phpbb.com[/url]: https://www.phpbb.com [url=https://www.phpbb.com]Linked text[/url]: Linked text

[flash=width,height]Path to flash[/flash] will play the flash animation with the specified dimensions

For videos, simply copy the URL of the video into the content area.
