





Using a #12 painting brush, apply a heavy dry brush, almost completely covering the piece.

Next, mix Water Bubbles Blue, Arcane Acid, and Base Grey in a 4:1:1 ratio, then add a few drops of Lava Orange.

For this mix, paint an even opaque coat on the stalagmites, stalactites water pools, and veins.






ARCANE ACID (GT002-AA) Use **Arcane Acid** to color in the pools and veins.

Once the paint has dried, you can add clear nail polish or a gloss gel medium to the pools and veins.

STEP 4

BASE GREY (GT002-BG) + CAVERN STONE DRY BRUSH (GT002-CD) + WATER BUBBLES BLUE (GT002-BB) When everything is dry, make a mixture of **Base Grey**, **Cavern Stone Dry Brush**, and **Water Bubbles Blue** in a 3:1:1 ratio.

Apply a light, even dry brush over the entire piece. This is the key step to bringing out all the hand-sculpted details.



LAVA ORANGE (GT002-LO) Search your pieces for thoughtful touches. These are tiny Easter eggs hidden throughout the Caverns Deep pieces.

Paint the Mushroom Cluster on the Cascading Pool Corner piece (CV-606) Lava Orange.





CAVERN STONE DRY BRUSH (GT002-CD) On the 45° Passage (CP-602), paint the exterior wall bones **Black** then go over the Black with **Cavern Stone Dry Brush**.

Applying the Black first allows the Caverns Dry Brush to pop because it provides more contrast.



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
