

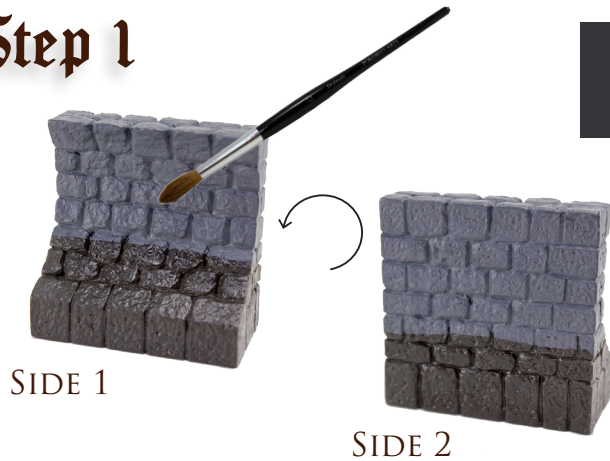

PAINTING GUIDE

SW-004 - SEWER WALL



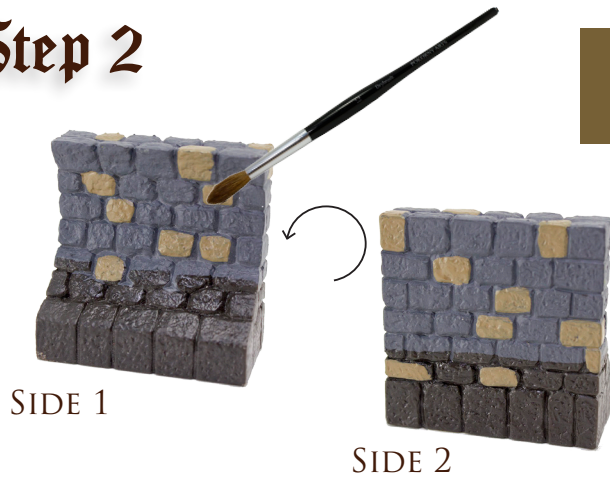
Step 1



BASE GRAY
(GT002-BG)

Apply **Base Gray** over the upper surface and edges of the piece using a #3 (Painting) brush. Apply the paint into the cracks between the stones, or leave the cracks unpainted to create more texture. Let the paint dry before moving to the next step.

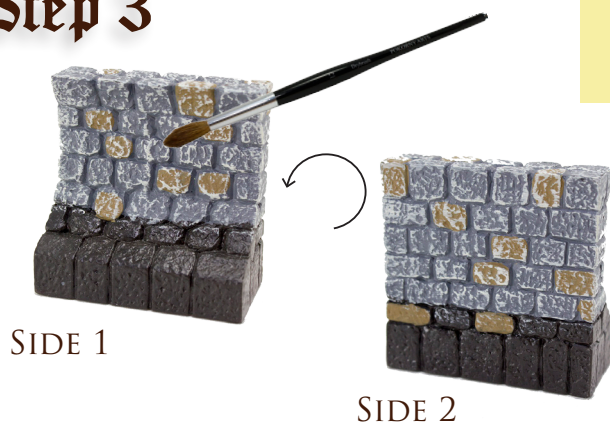
Step 2



CARDBOARD
(GT002-CB)

Apply **Cardboard** to random stones on the stone facing using a #1 (Details) brush. This will add more detail to the stones. Let the paint dry before moving to the next step.

Step 3



STONE EDGE
DRYBRUSH
(GT002-SE)

Dab a very small amount of **Stone Edge Drybrush** onto a #12 (Drybrush) brush, then brush onto a paper towel to remove excess paint. With a feather light touch, apply over the face of the upper stones. Be careful not to overdo it! Let the paint dry before moving to the next step.

Step 4



SIDE 1

SLUDGE*
(GT002-SD)

Dab a very small amount of **Sludge** onto a #12 (Drybrush) brush, then brush onto a paper towel to remove excess paint. With a feather light touch, apply over the surface of the lower stone facing, leaving the deeper areas unpainted. Let the paint dry before moving to the next step.

Step 5



SIDE 1



SIDE 2

SHALLOW WATER
SEAWEED GREEN
(GT002-SG)

Dab a very small amount of **Shallow Water Seaweed Green** onto a #12 (Drybrush) brush, then brush onto a paper towel to remove excess paint. With a feather light touch, apply over the surface of the lower stone facing.

Pro tip: Using a #3 (Painting) brush, apply a clear coat (we recommend **Golden® Soft (Gloss) Gel Medium**) to the lower parts of the sewer walls to create a wet appearance. Find a Golden® Artist Colors store near you at www.goldenpaints.com/store_locator

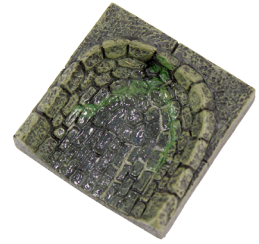

SW-011 - DEAD END SLUICEWAY



Step 1



SHALLOW WATER
SEAWEED GREEN
(GT002-SG)

Using a #1 (Details) brush, apply **Shallow Water Seaweed Green** to the sewer floor in a random pattern to create a sludge midtone. Let the paint dry before moving to the next step.

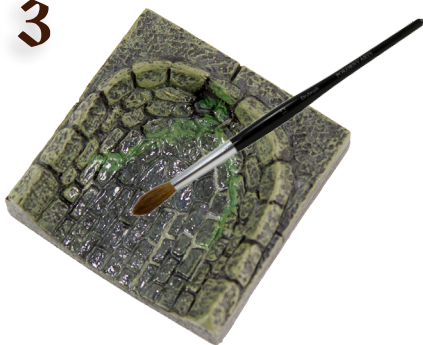
Step 2



SLUDGE
(GT002-SD)

Dab a very small amount of **Sludge** onto a #12 (Drybrush) brush, then brush onto a paper towel to remove excess paint. To create the highlights, paint over the entire surface and edges of the piece with a feather light touch. Let the paint dry before moving to the next step.

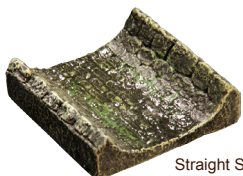

(GLOSS) MEDIUM

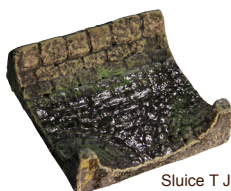
Using a #3 (Painting) brush, apply a clear coat (we recommend Golden® Soft Gel Gloss Medium) to the sewer floor to create a wet appearance.

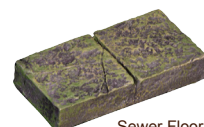

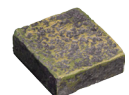
Sluice 4-Way Crossing
